- "Is [Hospital Name] an option for me?"
- "Why is this transfer necessary?"
- "Who can I talk to about choosing where I go?"
- "How does my insurance affect my choices?"



# HOW TO MAKE THE RIGHT CHOICE FOR YOU

- ☐ Think about what's important to you, consider family support, specialized care, and distance.
- Consider staying local if your medical needs can be met closer to home.
- Ask about all available options, not just the default recommendation.
- Your care team can help you weigh the benefits of different hospitals.
- Remember, the best choice is the one that meets your family's needs with the right level of care.
